TRIMESTER COURSE

STANDARDS MET: MN ACADEMIC STANDARDS IN *ART*

CURRICULUM: ESSENTIAL OUTCOMES

1. STUDENTS WILL IDENTIFY ARTWORK FROM ANCIENT AND PREHISTORIC TIMES, SUCH AS HISTORIC CAVE ART AND ANCIENT EGYPTIAN ART.
2. STUDENTS WILL NAME THE 12 COLORS ON THE COLOR WHEEL.
3. STUDENTS WILL IDENTIFY THE ELEMENTS OF ART IN NATURAL AND MAN-MADE FORMS.
4. STUDENTS WILL CREATE AN ORIGINAL ARTWORK, WHICH UTILIZES THE SPATIAL CONCEPTS OF FOREGROUND, MIDDLE GROUND AND BACKGROUND.
5. STUDENTS WILL FIND AND IDENTIFY INFORMATION ON A CREDIT LINE FOR A WORK OF ART.
6. STUDENTS WILL IDENTIFY THE SUBJECT MATTER OF AN ARTWORK.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO TAKE RESPONSIBILITY IN THE CLASSROOM ESPECIALLY FOR BEHAVIOR AND CLEAN UP.

PROJECTS ARE DUE ONE WEEK AFTER THE FIRST LAB FOR THE UNIT. IF A STUDENT HAS AN EXCUSED ABSENCE, ASSIGNMENTS/PROJECTS WILL BE ACCEPTED LATE FOR FULL CREDIT WITH A PARENT SIGNATURE. THERE WILL BE A FEW TIMES WHEN NO LATE WORK IS ALLOWED. STUDENTS WILL KNOW IN ADVANCE.

GRADING PROCEDURES:

GRADING IS WEIGHTED: PROJECTS 50%, BEHAVIOR/ATTITUDE/EFFORT 9%, QUIZZES AND ASSIGNMENTS/HOMEWORK 20%, TESTS 20%, AND BONUS POINTS 1%. STUDENTS WILL BE GIVEN NUMEROUS OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE ENHANCEMENT OF THEIR GRADES WITH SIDE PROJECTS RELATING TO THE MAJOR UNIT OF WORK. STUDENTS HAVE ONE WEEK TO COMPLETE ARTWORK AT THE END OF A UNIT. WORK WILL BE ACCEPTED LATE WITH A NOTE AND SIGNATURE FROM A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
